

**WYRE FOREST DISTRICT COUNCIL
 WELCHGATE AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT AREA (NITROGEN DIOXIDE)
 ORDER 2002
 SECTION 83(1) ENVIRONMENT ACT 1995
 ORDER DESIGNATING AN AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT AREA**

Whereas the Wyre Forest District Council ("the Council") is satisfied that as a result of its air quality review and assessment dated July 2002, the annual mean air quality objective for Nitrogen Dioxide is not likely to be achieved by 31st December 2005 (being the relevant period prescribed by the Air Quality (England) Regulations 2000) in the area described in the schedule below, for reasons both of the current and projected exceedence of the objective.

Now therefore the council in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 83(1) of the Environment Act 1995, hereby makes the following Order.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT;

1. The area shown shaded (in red) on the attached map which forms part of this Order and described in the schedule below shall be designated as an Air Quality Management Area, to be known as Welchgate Air Quality Management Area (Nitrogen Dioxide).
2. The Air Quality Management Area be specific to Nitrogen Dioxide only by virtue of likely exceedences predicted of the annual mean objective for the year 2005 in the range of 40.0 to 45.7 μgm^{-3} .
3. The Order be cited as the Wyre Forest District Council (Welchgate Air Quality Management Area (Nitrogen Dioxide)) Order ~~2002~~ ²⁰⁰³ *PK*
4. The Order shall come into force on the ~~6th January~~ ²⁰⁰² and shall remain in force until varied or revoked by subsequent Order. *2003 PK*
