

Pavement Licence - example plan

The plan you provide with your application forms part of your licence so it is important that it includes the information needed to identify the area of the highway you are allowed to use.

The plan below is an example that you can use when creating one for your application.

Points to note

When producing your plan, make sure that you include an indication of how you want to lay out your furniture. You should show tables and chairs and any other items included in your application, such as parasols, planters, or barriers. Clearly identify the area you intend to use. This can be done by any means, but a red line is one of the best ways to do this.

Include measurements of the area itself, and the distance from the edge of the highway.

Show any existing street furniture such as bollards, waste bins, and street lighting.
