**THE BROMSGROVE DISTRICT COUNCIL AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT AREAS
REVOCATON ORDER 2025**

Bromsgrove District Council, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 83(2)(b) of the Environment Act 1995, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited/referred to as The Bromsgrove District Council Air Quality Management Areas Revocation Order 2025 and shall come into effect on 1st December 2025.
2. On 26th January 2001 Bromsgrove District Council ("the Council"), made the Bromsgrove District Council Lickey End Air Quality Management Area (Nitrogen Dioxide) Order ("the 2001 Order") declaring that the area shown shaded red on the map attached at Appendix 1 to be an Air Quality Management Area ("AQMA") for the pollutant Nitrogen Dioxide (NO₂).
3. On 7th February 2010 Bromsgrove District Council ("the Council"), made the Bromsgrove District Council Redditch Road Air Quality Management Area (Nitrogen Dioxide) Order ("the 2010 Order") declaring that the area shown edged red on the map attached at Appendix 2 to be an Air Quality Management Area ("AQMA") for the pollutant Nitrogen Dioxide (NO₂).
4. The effect of this order is to revoke the two AQMA areas as described above (the 2001 Order and the 2010 Order) and as shown on the two maps attached to this order at Appendix 1 and Appendix 2.

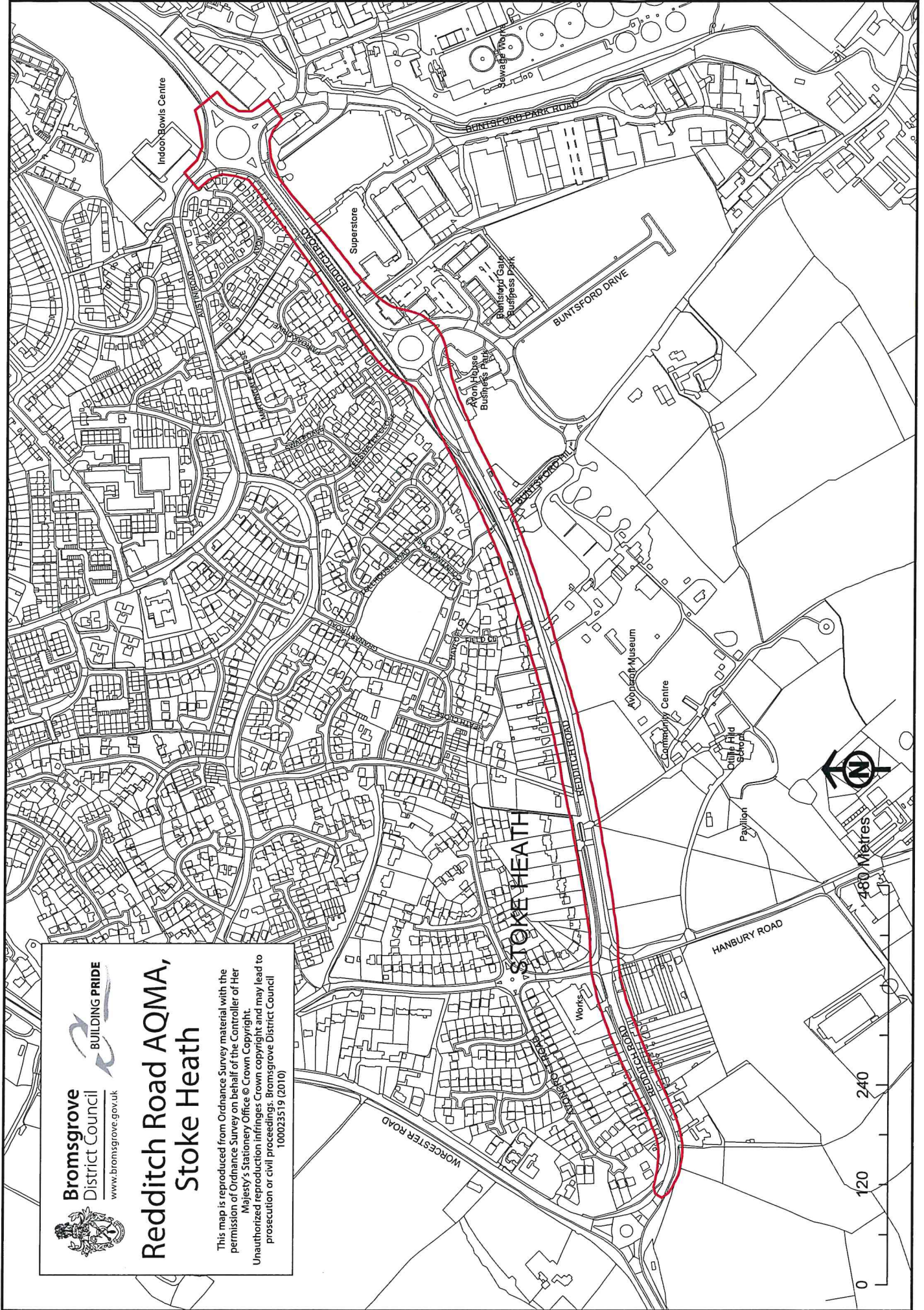
